

Get Out the Vote in Utah



**The voter registration deadline in Utah,
for the November 2024 election,
is Friday, October 25.**



ID Requirements

In Utah, photo ID is required to cast a ballot. If registering to vote on election day, voters must provide two acceptable forms of ID. One will verify identity and the other will verify residence.

Absentee Voting

All registered voters in Utah will automatically receive a ballot in the mail.

Absentee ballots must be postmarked by Monday, November 4. Voters can also return absentee ballots to drop boxes until 8 pm on Tuesday, November 5.

Your absentee ballot cannot be hand delivered to your polling place on election day. You must return it via mail or drop box.

PFLAG recommends that voters get their ballots in the mailbox no later than Tuesday, October 22.

If you are in line to vote on election day when the polls close - STAY IN LINE. You must be allowed to cast your ballot.

Early Voting


All registered voters in Utah can vote early for any reason. Early voting begins as early as Tuesday, October 22 and ends Friday, November 1. Contact your county clerk for your county's specific dates, hours, and locations.

Voting on Election Day

Polls open in Utah at 7 am and close at 8 pm on Tuesday, November 5.
